**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Kuvempu Shatamanothsave Shikshana Mahavidyalaya, Zilla Vokkaligara Sangha, Balaraj URS Road, Shimoga-577201, Karnataka** run by **Zilla Vokkaligara Sangha, Balaraj URS Road, Shimoga, Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2005-2006/14852 dt. 21.12.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC withdrawn the recognition of the institution vide order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO3105/2010-2011/20174 dated 02.08.2010.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC issued a restoration order for granting B.Ed course vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/2010-2011/26624 dt. 01.02.2011.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 20.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter was sent to the institution regarding VT inspection on 13.06.2016. Accordingly, as per the direction of the SRC the inspection was conducted on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2016 and the VT Report received in this office on 21.10.2016.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 381<sup>th</sup> meeting decided to issue Show Cause Notice to all such institution where the institution(s) has not submitted requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents in response to RPRO. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 06.11.2019. The institution vide letter dated 05.12.2019 submitted its reply to the show cause notice. The SRC in its 383<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 07<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the original documents and records submitted by the institution on 09.12.2019 in respect of Show Cause Notice. The Committee decided that the

continuation order be issued to Kuvempu Shatamanothsave Shikshana Mahavidyalaya, Zilla Vokkaligara Sangha, Karnataka for B.Ed programme for 2 units (50 students each unit) .

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. Kuvempu Shatamanothsave Shikshana Mahavidyalaya, Sy. No. 14, Ward No. 10, Zilla Vokkaligara Sangha, Balaraj URS Road, Shimoga- 577201, Karnataka run by Zilla Vokkaligara Sangha, Balaraj URS Road, Shimoga- 577201, Karnataka for continuation of recognition for B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of (Two unit) of 50 students each subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

8. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.

9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

10. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:

- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

11. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

12. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

13. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.

This is to convey that with reference to the revised order dated 16.05.2015 issued to your institution for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 2 units of 50 each (100), the SRC has decided to Cause inspection for verification of infrastructural and instructional facilities. The inspection will be carried out between 10 to 30 days.

You are now requested to be ready with the various infrastructural and instructional facilities as per the norms and standards prescribed by NCTE and fill all the details in the questionnaire enclosed to this letter. The same will be verified physically by the visiting team members

It is requested that originals of the following documents should be kept ready and made available to the Visiting Team during the time of inspection as per NCTE Rules and Regulations and hand over a copy to the Visiting team for submission to SRC along with the report.

- 1) Land documents registered / issued by the competent authority showing that the applicant Society / Trust / Organisation / body has the requisite land to conduct the programme/s applied for as on date.
- 2) Building Plan approved by the competent authority showing the details of the location, site area, built up area with ear marking for the existing and proposed programmes.
- 3) Building completion certificate issued by Government Engineer to the Society sponsoring the institution showing the details of the programmes to be conducted, built up area, type of roofing and size of Multipurpose hall.
- 4) Encumbrance Certificate that the land area submitted for the programme/s is free from encumbrance.
- 5) Land Use Certificate issued by the Thasildhar / Revenue Divisional Officer that the land can be used for educational purpose.
- 6) Staff list approved by the affiliating body as per Regulations 2014.
- 7) Affiliation orders from affiliating body for 2015-16.
- 8) FDR's in joint account for Rs.5,00,000/- & Rs.7,00,000/- Lakhs.
- 9) Details of other programmes conducted in the same campus.

ORDER

**WHEREAS**, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

**2. AND WHEREAS**, the institution **Kuvempu Shatamanothsave Shikshana Mahavidyalaya, Zilla Vokkaligara Sangha, Balaraj Urs Road, Shimoga – 577201, Karnataka** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in **B.Ed** which require additional facilities.

**3. AND WHEREAS**, on scrutiny it is found that the institution has not maintained/revalidated the Fixed Deposited Receipts towards Endowment and Reserve Funds.

**4. AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- I. The institution shall submit revalidated FDRs of the enhanced values, in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 failing which the recognition will be withdrawn.
- II. The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- III. The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
- IV. The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.

**5. NOW THEREFORE**, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Kuvempu Shatamanothsave Shikshana Mahavidyalaya, Zilla Vokkaligara Sangha, Balaraj Urs Road, Shimoga – 577201, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed** programme of **two years** duration with an annual intake of **100** for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session **2015-16** subject to submission of revalidated FDRs of the enhanced value in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 and fulfilment of the conditions mentioned at II & III herein before 31.10.2015.

**Preamble:**

Kuvempu Shatamanthsava Shikshana Mahavidyalaya, Zilla Vokkaligara Sangha, Balaraj Urs Road, Shimoga-577201, Karnataka has submitted application for offering B.Ed course on 21.01.2004. The institution has been granted recognition by SRC for offering B.Ed course with an intake of 100 students vide order dated 21.12.2005.


The matter of shifting of the institution from temporary premises to permanent premises was considered in the 176<sup>th</sup> meeting of SRC held on 27-28 May, 2009. The Committee decided to serve Notice to the institution and Notice was served to the institution on 31.08.2009. The institution has submitted reply to the Notice on 22.9.2009 and 25.9.2009.

The Committee in its 185<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 26-27 November 2009 considered the matter and decided to conduct inspection under Section 17 of NCTE Act after submission of fee of Rs. 40,000/- by the institution. Accordingly, a letter to the institution was issued on 06.01.2010 to submit the inspection fee of Rs.40,000/-.

As the institution has not submitted the reply to the letter dated 06.01.2010, the matter was placed before SRC in its 189<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25-26 February 2010. SRC decided to issue notice.

In the meantime, the institution has submitted Rs.40,000/- towards inspection fee for shifting of premises on 15.03.2010 bearing No.843101 dated 09.03.2010.

Further, the documents pertaining to land ownership was examined and it is ascertained that the documents which was submitted in response to this office letter are the one and the same that have been submitted at the time of making application. The State Government of Karnataka vide its proceedings dt.12.12.1947, establishes that the Society was granted land measuring one acre and one gunta. The same land documents were shown while submitting the initial application. SRC in its 190<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 29-30 March 2010 decided to cause inspection under section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, inspection was carried out on 10.06.2010. The SRC in its 193<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 21-22 June, 2010 considered VT report and decided to withdraw the recognition.

Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 02.08.2010. The institution moved Hon'ble High court of Karnataka in W.P.25870 of 2010 and passed judgement dated 09.11.2010 which reads as follows:

The 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent (NCTE) is directed to cause inspection of the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner-College and file a report before this Court regarding the availability of infrastructure to impart education in B.Ed course, subject to the petitioner depositing prescribed inspection fee with the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent within a period of two weeks from today. The 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent shall conduct the inspection, as above, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of inspection fee and file a report in this case immediately after the inspection.


Accordingly, as per directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka, the institution vide letter dated 22.11.2010 has submitted Rs.40,000/- DD towards re-inspection fee. Inspection was carried out on 28.12.2010. The inspection report has been received along with VCD. A copy of the visiting team report was forwarded to the Advocate on 12.01.2011 for filing before the court.

SRC in its 200th meeting held on 20-21 January 2011 considered the VT report and other related documents and decided to restore/continue recognition accorded to the institution for the B.Ed course.

Hence the order.

SRC in its 190th meeting held on 29-30 March 2010 decided to cause inspection under section 17 of NCTE Act.

Accordingly, inspection was carried out on 10.06.2010. The Committee considered the VT report and decided to withdraw recognition for the following reasons:-


As per VT Report and as countersigned by the Management,

- The built-up-space is only 4408.12 sq.ft. which is far short of NCTE norms of 16,000 sq.ft.
- The built-up-area as per VTR is 7400 sq.ft., but when calculated it comes to 4408.12sq.ft. Even if the VTR data is to be taken, it is far less than the norms.
- The Library books numbering 1458 only are related to Education which is less than the NCTE norms.
- Facilities provided for E.T. lab. & Physical Education are inadequate.
- As per VTR, the Physical Science Methodology teacher is not qualified as per NCTE norms.
- A separate room has to be provided for Physical Education.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that recognition accorded to **Kuvempu Shathamanothsava Shikshana Mahavidyalaya, Shimoga- 577201, Karnataka B.Ed** course is **withdrawn**.

As per Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, there is provision to prefer an appeal against the above order of withdrawn of recognition order. A copy of the format to prefer the appeal is enclosed along with this order.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Kuvempu Shatamanothsava Shikshana Mahavidyalaya, Zilla Vokkaligara Sangha, Balaraj Urs Road, Shimoga-577201, Karnataka Karnataka for Secondary(B.Ed) course of one year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 100 students subject to fulfillment of the following.

- b. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
  - c. The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)
  - d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the affiliating University, UGC, State Government etc.
  5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
